
VIA Rail – Arrive in Jasper

Explore Jasper

Jasper is a great base for exploring Jasper National Park, the largest park in the Canadian Rockies. The small town of Jasper offers visitors a laid-back mountain experience with equal opportunities for adventure, discovery and relaxation.

Morning Wildlife Discovery Tour of Jasper

Take in the beautiful winter landscape and spot wildlife around Jasper on a sightseeing bus tour.



Maligne Valley Tour with Pleckaitis Canyon Icewalk

Travel deep into the heart of the Maligne Valley on a guided tour, with stops highlighting the ecology of fire as well as untouched scenic landscapes. You'll have the opportunity to walk on ice at the bottom of one of Jasper's deepest accessible canyons, surrounded by towering rock walls.




Jasper Snowshoe Tour

Warm up after your outdoor winter activity on an afternoon tasting tour of Jasper's best eateries. Sample Canadian classics, locally brewed beers, and globally inspired cuisine.



Travel the Icefields Parkway to Lake Louise

Breathe in the fresh mountain air and sip a warm cup of coffee before you travel to Lake Louise today. Once you arrive, explore this world-famous frozen lake and the ancient glacier and mountains that surround it.



Interpretive Transfer to Lake Louise

Enjoy a small-group transfer along the world-famous Icefields Parkway between Jasper and Lake Louise. With your driver-guide, stop to admire views of ancient glaciers, winding rivers, and frozen waterfalls.



Suggested Upgrade: Winter Heli Safari (Extra Cost)

Travel along the Icefields Parkway with a private guide. Stop at Abraham Lake to soar above the mountains by helicopter, then see beautiful bubble formations trapped in ice.




Lake Louise Sleigh Ride

Day 07

Lake Louise to Banff

Explore Banff

The town of Banff is nestled amidst the soaring peaks of Banff National Park, Canada's oldest national park. The park is home to some of the most captivating scenery in North America. Banff is small enough to walk around and has plenty of world-class eateries and boutiques.

You have **3 options** to choose from today:



Dogsledding Tour

Travel to the Canmore area, where you will meet a team of friendly huskies waiting to whisk you through the snowy wilderness. Harness the dogs and drive the team yourself, or simply enjoy the experience as a passenger.



Banff Sightseeing Tour and Gondola Ride

On this small-group bus tour, discover Banff's unique heritage, enchanting folklore, and stunning backdrop in the Canadian Rockies. Stop at some scenic viewpoints before riding a gondola to the summit of Sulphur Mountain.



Ice Walk plus Nightrise Gondola Admission with Transportation

Enjoy the beauty of winter while you explore Johnston Canyon. Wander along steel catwalks built into the canyon walls to discover frozen waterfalls, and learn about the wildlife and geology of the area. This evening, take a Gondola ride at dusk to experience a unique 'Nightrise' lights show.


